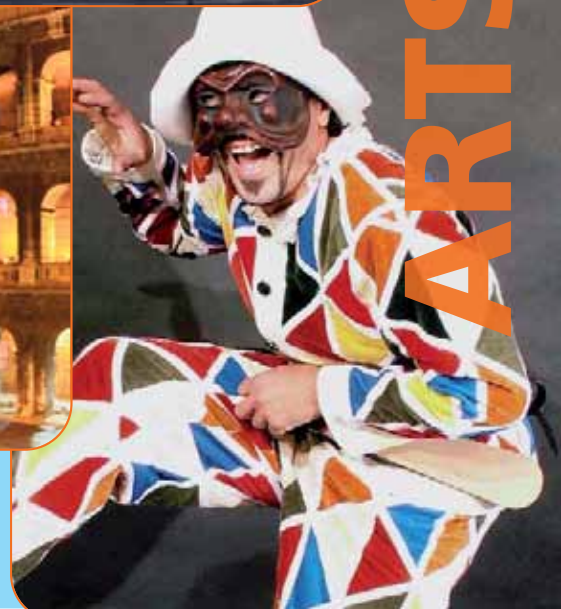

COURSES

GRUMENTUM: A TOUR IN THE ROMAN ART AND ARCHAEOLOGY

DURATION: 1 week / **STRUCTURE:** The course is organized for 25 hours of contact. The lectures are 3 hours for 5 days, from Monday to Friday. The course includes class lectures, training and archaeological workshops for a total of 25 hours, divided in 15 hours of theory and 10 of practice. / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** English / **DESCRIPTION:** Through the lectures and the training the course propose to provide the knowledge and the basis of Roman civilization (arts, architecture, town planning) from the origins to the Middle Age considering also the relations with other cultures (in particular with the Greeks). THE KNIGHTS: ON THE TRACE OF ANCIENT CONQUEROR

DURATION: 2 weeks / **STRUCTURE:** This course is structured in 50 hours. Day classes are 3 hours long for 5 days a week, Monday to Friday. The course consists of 30 hours of lectures and 20 hours educational visits, for a total of 50 hours / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** English / **DESCRIPTION:** he course offers lectures and a series of multidisciplinary visits that illustrate the close connection between architecture and history on the Italian territory. The course introduces students to the evolution of medieval architecture in Italy, in chronological order from the early Christian era and the Gothic period up to the study of the major architectural works built in the early Christian period, in the Barbarian kingdoms, in the Carolingian era. The course are schedules overviews and analysis of the main medieval monuments in Italy to identify the changes and the persistence of the architecture models during the Middle Ages and will enhance the knowledge of architectural forms based on the original intended use. During the second part of the course there will be visits some of medieval architecture in the city of Basilicata, both civil and religious, especially the Abbey of the Trinity of Venosa and the Cathedral Acerenza. The visits will enable students to understand those monuments or a works of art that can best embody the spirit of a certain age. For each period presented, in fact, it will be taken into consideration one or more works within the most representative pathways in Basilicata: Frederick route of the castles (Melfi, Lago-

HERACLEA AND SIRIS: A TOUR IN THE MAGNA GRAECIA

DURATION: 1 week / **STRUCTURE**: 3 hours per day, 5 days a week, from Monday to Friday. The course sees seminars and practical exercises for a total of 25 hours, 15 hours of classes and 10 hours to share between laboratories and archaeological trip / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING**: English / **DESCRIPTION**: The training course sees theoretical and practical lessons, including guided tours to monuments, excavation areas and museums in the Basilicata region; the aim is to develop the knowledge of national and local archaeological heritage. Through the direct study of historical testimonials, students will acquire the understanding of the main historical eras which lead to colonial expansion of the Greek Empire in Italy. ITINERA AQUAE: AQUEDUCTS OF ANCIENT ROME

DURATION: 3 days / **STRUCTURE:** 1 theory lecture (2 hours per lecture) plus 2 full days / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** Italian, English, Spanish / **DESCRIPTION:** The course will focus on the aqueduct system of ancient Rome, made up of 11 aqueducts built in the period between the republican and imperial periods. Students will learn about the techniques and main characteristics used to build the aqueducts in lectures and visits to archaeological sites in Rome and nearby. The names of the sites to be visited will be communicated during the lectures as they can change due to the bureaucratic difficulties to access most archaeological sites in Rome / **OUTPUT:** Certificate of attendance / **COST OF THE COURSE:** 300,00 € (minimum 6 participants) / **DATE OF START:** Weekly from the 1st of July / **OBJECTIVES:** To analyse the water supply system of ancient Rome, with a stress on the different technologies used,

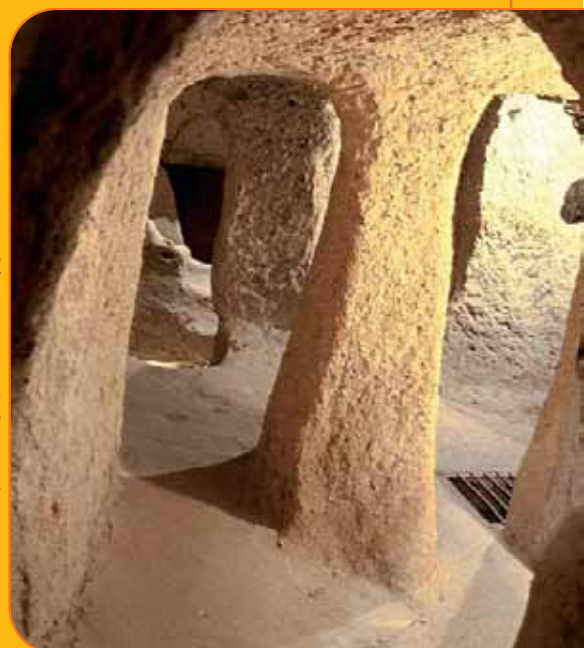


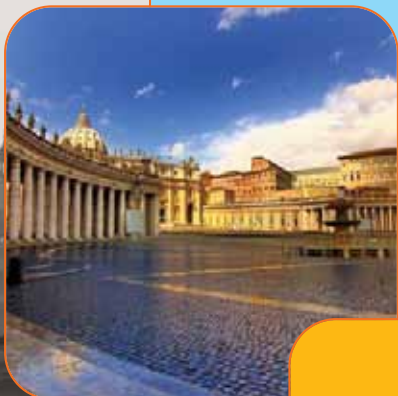
AVERNO: ANCESTORS WORSHIP IN ANCIENT ROME

DURATION: 3 days / **STRUCTURE:** 1 theory lecture (3 hours) plus 2 full days / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** Italian, English, Spanish / **DESCRIPTION:** Historically, both in the republican and imperial periods, worshipping ancestors has always been a common practice and a very important one, both culturally and for the different types of underground tombs that hosted the body of the ancestors. The course will analyse both columbarium and catacombs. The names of the sites to be visited will be communicated during the lectures as they can change due to the bureaucratic difficulties to access most archaeological sites in Rome / **OUTPUT:** Certificate of attendance / **COST OF THE COURSE:** 300,00 € (minimum 6 participants) / **DATE OF START:** Weekly from the 1st of July / **OBJECTIVES:** To describe ancestors worship in ancient Rome, with a particular focus on the differences between pagans and Christians, from 300 BC to 400 AD. / **PROGRAMME:** See details on the web site: www.linksummer.it / **COURSE LOCATION:** Rome

THE UNDERGROUNDS OF ROME: SPELEAN ARCHAEOLOGY

ACROBATICS WORKSHOP

DURATION: 1 week / **STRUCTURE:** Total of 36 hours divided in 6 daily hours. (Maximum 25 students) / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** Italian (it is possible to have an interpreter for the classes in English) / **DESCRIPTION:** The course will be of a practical nature and is designed to recognize the level of muscular elasticity and the individual difficulties. Some of the practical exercises will include: patè, flic-flac, falls, comic entrances, cartwheels, all aimed at using acrobatics within the spectrum of comedy gags / **OUTPUT:** Certificate of attendance / **COST OF THE COURSE:** 450,00 € The cost is referred only to the workshop lectures. The student will charge: training aid, room and board / **DATE OF START:** From Monday 13th July to Saturday 18th July / **OBJECTIVES:** The main objective of the course is to explore the individual's physical potential through the concepts of "centering" and "balance". This will lead to the construction of a different physicality, where the body is deconstructed and reconstructed. The students will rediscover their own body and be able to use it as an essential element of the characters they build on stage. COMEDIA DELL'ARTE

DURATION: 1 week / **STRUCTURE:** 48 hours in total divided in 8 daily hours. (Maximum 25 students) / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** Italian (it is possible to have an interpreter for the classes in English) / **OUTPUT:** Certificate of attendance / **COST OF THE COURSE:** 450,00 € The cost is referred only to the workshop lectures. The student will charge: training aid, room and board / **DATE OF START:** From Monday 6th July to Saturday 11th July / **OBJECTIVES:** The course is based on the Italian "commedia dell'arte" and the use of the mask. There will be a brief amount of work based on Improvisation techniques as used in the similar form of "farsa giullaresca" (a farce based on the commedia characters). There will be research on the history of comedy and an analysis of the different elements which have characterised the different forms of comic theatre. We will discover a theatre founded on the principle of provocation, which becomes self-inventive, thus creating "An industry of entertainment" exploiting the maximum potential of the playful nature of the stage. This means that the dramatic text as used by actors throughout the 16th century is rejected and transformed in a machine able to produce endless shows without the need of a formal playtext. Commedia

dell'Arte encapsulated within itself the fascinating secret of having made comedy actors transcend their own time and therefore being able to survive successfully all the way through to our modern age / **PROGRAMME:** See details on the web site: www.linksummer.it / **COURSE LOCATION:** Città della Pieve

ACTING IN ENGLISH

DURATION: 1 week / **STRUCTURE:** Total of 36 hours divided in 6 daily hours. (Maximum 25 students) / **LANGUAGE OF TEACHING:** English / **DESCRIPTION:** William Shakespeare is possibly the most well-know English playwright. His plays have been translated in many languages and audiences belonging to all cultures and countries have been able to enjoy the multitude of stories and characters portrayed through them. And yet, no matter how good the translation, there is only one language which allows actors to fully explore Shakespeare's poetry and genius: Elizabethan English. It is the rhythm and musicality inherent in Shakespeare's text

that contribute so significantly to the understanding of the characters and situations exposed in the plays. Through the pentameter's beat pulsing in every line of verse, through the numerous images and the sounds within the very words, Shakespeare's texts become a living and ever-changing canvas for the actor to explore and experiment the infinite possibilities of the characters and his own art / **OUTPUT:** Certificate of attendance / **COST OF THE COURSE:** 450,00 € The cost is referred only to the workshop lectures. This will happen within the boundaries of a stage where fiction and reality fuse into performance. From the idea of controlling one's body, we will arrive at the control of a weapon, the sword, which in ancient times was not only used for defense, but also for attacking. Before reaching the sword, the students will have learned other forms of stage combat such as group fighting without weapons and bare fist fighting and the use of the dagger / **OUTPUT:** Certificate of attendance / **COST OF THE COURSE:** 450,00 € The cost is referred only to the workshop lectures. SUMMER@LINK | CITTÀ DELLA PIEVE

Città della Pieve is a charming medieval town, situated on a hill between the rivers Nestore and Chiani, overlooking the Valdichiana and Trasimeno Lake. Located on the border between Tuscany and Lazio, it was probably erected in the Etruscan era. Città della Pieve was the birthplace of the painter Pietro Vannucci known as "Il Perugino". Some of his famous paintings, like the Adoration of the Magi (1504), can be admired at Città della Pieve. In 1550, Pope Julius III assigned the government of Città della Pieve to Ascanio Corgna, determining the arrival of artists mainly engaged in construction and decoration of the magnificent palace that takes his name. This Palazzo is also the site of Link Campus University.

Located in the historic centre, opposite to the Cathedral, the Palazzo della Corgna, strongly desired by the Corgna Ascanio to give prestige to the Governance, was completed by his nephew Diomede. The project is attributed to Galeazzo Alessi; the interior is richly frescoed by Pomarancio and Salvio Savini (1580) with mythological paintings in the Tuscan-Roman late-Mannerist style.



SUMMER@LINK | MONTESCAGLIOSO

The summer courses of the Link Campus University will take place, at Montescaglioso, inside the Benedictine Abbey "San Michele Arcangelo".

This monument is located in the old part of town: the first historical information dates back to the eleventh century. It reaches the maximum glory from the sixteenth century until 1784, when the monks abandoned to move to the town of Lecce.

The building has 365 rooms on three floors: the underground with deposits and cellars, the ground floor with rooms and refectory and the first floor with cells, the abbot's room, the guesthouse, the infirmary and the library. Equipped with two cloisters and many frescoes, the monument is also the main office of the Civitas Severiana Foundation, after the ancient Roman name of the town. A peasant exhibition on the daily life of the inhabitants of the area can also be visited.

The territory of Montescaglioso is part of an archaeological and historical area and is well connected to other important centres: the network has created the "Parco Archeologico delle Chiese Rupestri (rupestri means rocky) del Materano" (Murgia Park of Materano) which covers an area of 8000 hectares. Besides the cultural heritage, the surroundings of Montescaglioso include natural protected oasis and parks, and beaches awarded the blue flag of Europe, which certify the good quality of sea water and services.
